

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 500 (Master)

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 500 will hold a regular Master District meeting on **Wednesday, April 4, 2018, at 12:30 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Rio Grande Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.

3. Energy market update and energy proposals, including approve letter of authorization.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments, collection of monthly charges for operation and maintenance, and purchase of wastewater treatment plant, phase 2 expansion.
5. Report on security matters.
6. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, and maintenance.
7. Wildlife management, including report and proposals from A All Animal Control.
8. Engineering matters.
9. Preliminary planning for grade separation at Union Pacific Railroad and intersection improvements at Highway 290.
10. Approve Submerged Storm Sewer Agreements, Maintenance Agreements, and Storm Water Solutions, L.P. agreement.
11. Authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, and review bids and award construction contracts, including for the following construction projects:

 - b. Detention 1K (Phase Two);
 - c. Detention 1J (Phase Two); and
 - d. repair of tie-back walls; and
 - e. dredging of reservoirs (Phase One).

 22. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
 23. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
