- e. Section 43/46 park hardscape improvements, including proposal for park signage;
- f. wastewater treatment plant screening, including proposals for irrigation and, if appropriate, agreement with Heritage Homeowners' Association regarding same;
- g. pipeline easement landscape improvements;
- h. Greenhouse Road, Segment Five, hardscape improvements; and
- i. Greenhouse Road, Segment Five, landscape improvements.
