

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 500 (Master)

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 500 will hold a regular Master District meeting on **Wednesday, June 2, 2021, at 12:00 p.m.**, by teleconference* at Telephone Number: **888-363-4734**, Access Code: **8706826**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments (3-minute limit).
2. Approve minutes.
3. Receive electricity proposals and authorize appropriate action.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills, review of investments, collection of monthly charges for operation and maintenance, and fund transfers; and
 - b. update on potential refunding bond issue.
5. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs, maintenance; and
 - b. update on replacement of booster pump no. 1 motor at water plant no. 2.
6. Discuss lake management and maintenance, including:
 - a. wildlife management, including report and proposals from A All Animal Control; and
 - b. erosion, dredging, and water quality, including report from Erosion Control Committee.
7. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. grade separation at Union Pacific Railroad and intersection improvements at Highway 290, including:
 - i. preliminary engineering and Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT;
 - ii. update on Houston-Galveston Area Council Transportation Improvement Program participation;
 - iii. Interlocal Agreements with funding partners;
 - iv. project schedule; and
 - v. updated analysis of financial impact of project.
 - b. report on stormwater facilities maintenance and repairs, and approve Submerged Storm Sewer Agreements and Maintenance Agreements;
 - c. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, and review bids and award construction contracts, including for the following construction projects:
 - i. emergency water interconnect with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 196;
 - ii. water well no. 1;
 - iii. wastewater treatment plant no. 2;
 - iv. Mound Road east utility extension; and
 - v. water plant no. 1 hydropneumatic tank addition.

- d. approve pay estimates, change orders, substantial completion, final acceptance, termination, and/or settlement agreements, including for the following construction projects:
 - i. wastewater treatment plant aeration and digester basin rehabilitation;
 - ii. clearing and grubbing for Detention 1L;
 - iii. Towne Lake Section 60 temporary access road; and
 - iv. Detention 1L (Phase Two).
 - e. approve requests for capacity reservations and utility commitment letters; and
 - f. update on TPDES permit renewal application for Horsepen Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant.
8. Accept or grant conveyance of deeds, utility deeds, and easements, approve consents to encroachment, rights of entry, abandonments of easements and environmental proposals.
 9. Update on park bond application no. 1, surplus funds applications for emergency water interconnect facilities, water well no. 1, additional developer reimbursements, and preparation of bond application no. 11, including, if appropriate, adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Project and Bonds.
 10. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters, including surface water delivery.
 11. Landscape architect's report, including:
 - a. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, and review bids and award construction contracts for landscaping/park facilities, including for the following projects:
 - i. Greenhouse Road, Segment Six; and
 - ii. trails, trees, and sidewalks.
 - b. approve pay estimates and change orders, substantial completion, final acceptance, termination, and/or settlement agreements, for landscaping/park facilities.
 12. Report regarding development in the District.
 13. Reports from District consultants regarding District correspondence and provision of records.
 14. Discuss and, if appropriate, approve engagement letter with Thompson & Horton LLP.
 15. Review and revise action list.
