

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 500 (Master)

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 500 will hold a regular Master District meeting on **Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at The Lakehouse, 10000 Towne Lake Parkway, Cypress, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments (3-minute limit).
2. Approve minutes.
3. Authorize preparation of notice to Participant districts regarding proposed contract tax rate.
4. Renewal of District's insurance policies.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills, review of investments, collection of monthly charges for operation and maintenance, and fund transfers; and
 - b. adopt Resolution(s) Expressing Intent to Reimburse.
6. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs, and maintenance, and updates on sanitary sewer trunk line and manhole televising and cleaning, water well no. 1 motor replacement, and Tuckerton Road at Towne Lake Parkway manhole rehabilitation.
7. Discuss lake management and maintenance, including:
 - a. wildlife management, including report and proposals from A All Animal Control;
 - b. report from Towne Lake Community Association regarding lake and landscape maintenance matters, including update on island erosion control project; and
 - c. discuss Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of District Lakes, including report from special counsel and discuss pending or contemplated litigation and authorize appropriate action.
8. Report from Storm Water Solutions on stormwater facilities maintenance and repairs, including proposals, approve Submerged Storm Sewer Agreements and Maintenance Agreements, and updates on detention pond 1K outfall rehabilitation and erosion rehabilitation at Towne Lake Parkway and Tuckerton Road.
9. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. Grade separation at Union Pacific Railroad and intersection improvements at Highway 290, including:
 - i. update on Houston-Galveston Area Council Transportation Improvement Program participation;
 - ii. contractor change order requests; and
 - iii. construction schedule.
 - b. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, and review bids and award construction contracts, including for the following construction projects:

- i. reservoir dredging project, phase one, including authorize preparation of surplus funds notice letter;
 - ii. lift station no. 1 rehabilitation project;
 - iii. wastewater treatment plant no. 2 access road improvements; and
 - iv. lake erosion rehabilitation phase 2 project;
 - c. approve pay estimates, change orders, substantial completion, final acceptance, termination, and/or settlement agreements, including for the following construction projects:
 - i. wastewater treatment plant no. 1 emergency generator; and
 - ii. wastewater treatment plant no. 1 expansion, Phase 4 and access road improvements;
 - d. update on pond 1K mitigation basin system;
 - e. discuss options for water reuse, including report from reuse committee; and
 - f. approve requests for capacity reservations and utility commitment letters.
10. Accept or grant conveyance of deeds, utility deeds, and easements, approve consents to encroachment, rights of entry, abandonments of easements, and environmental proposals.
 11. Update on preparation of park bond application no. 2, including adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Project and Bonds.
 12. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters.
 13. Landscape architect's report, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award construction contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, substantial completion, and final acceptance, for landscaping/park facilities, including:
 - a. adopt amended Master Parks Plan;
 - b. landscape improvements for Tuckerton Road drill site;
 - c. Towne Lake Parkway sidewalk extension; and
 - d. update on Phase 3 landscaping appraisals and authorize preparation of Phase 4 appraisals, if appropriate.
 14. Report regarding development in the District.
 15. Reports from District consultants regarding District correspondence and provision of records.
 16. Review and revise action list.
